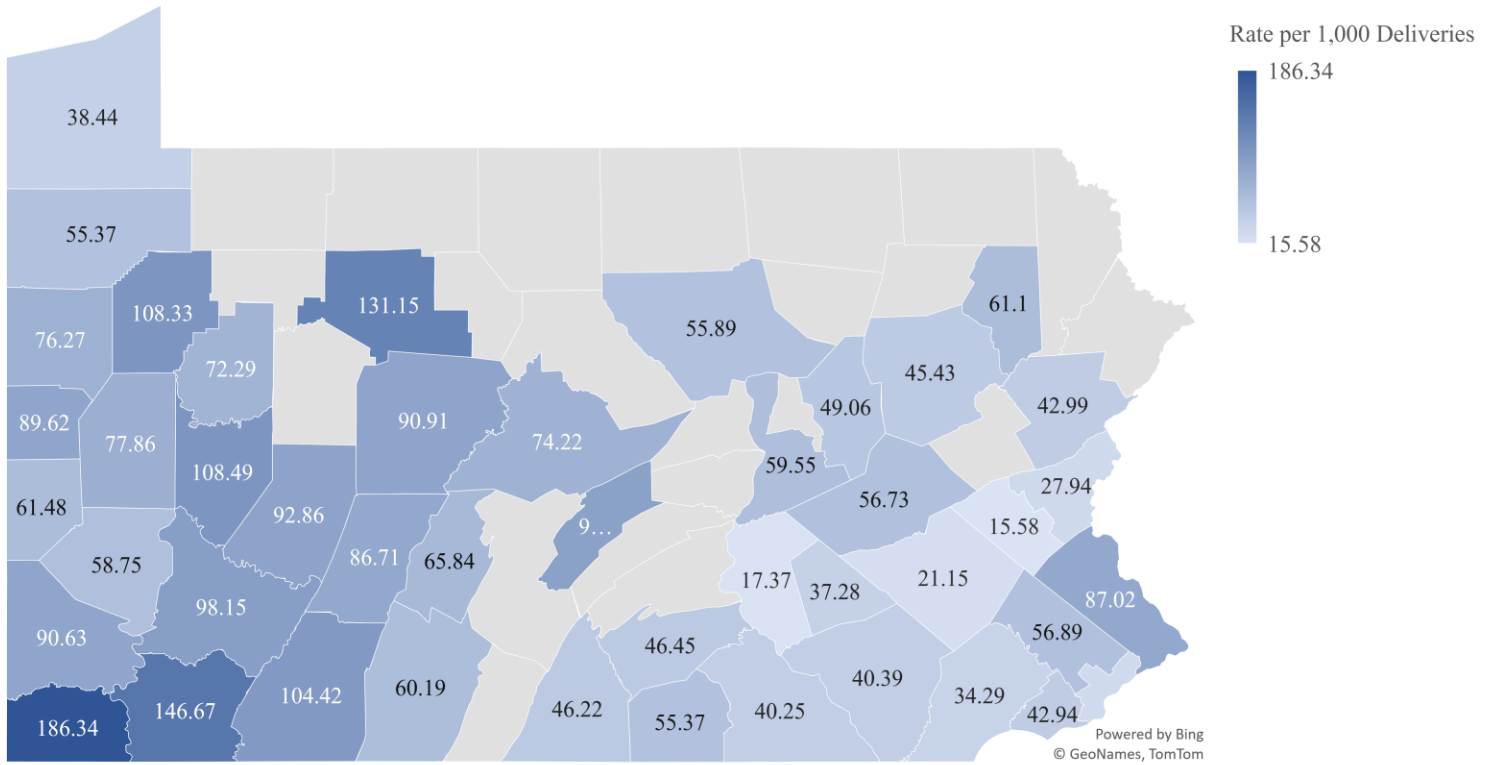

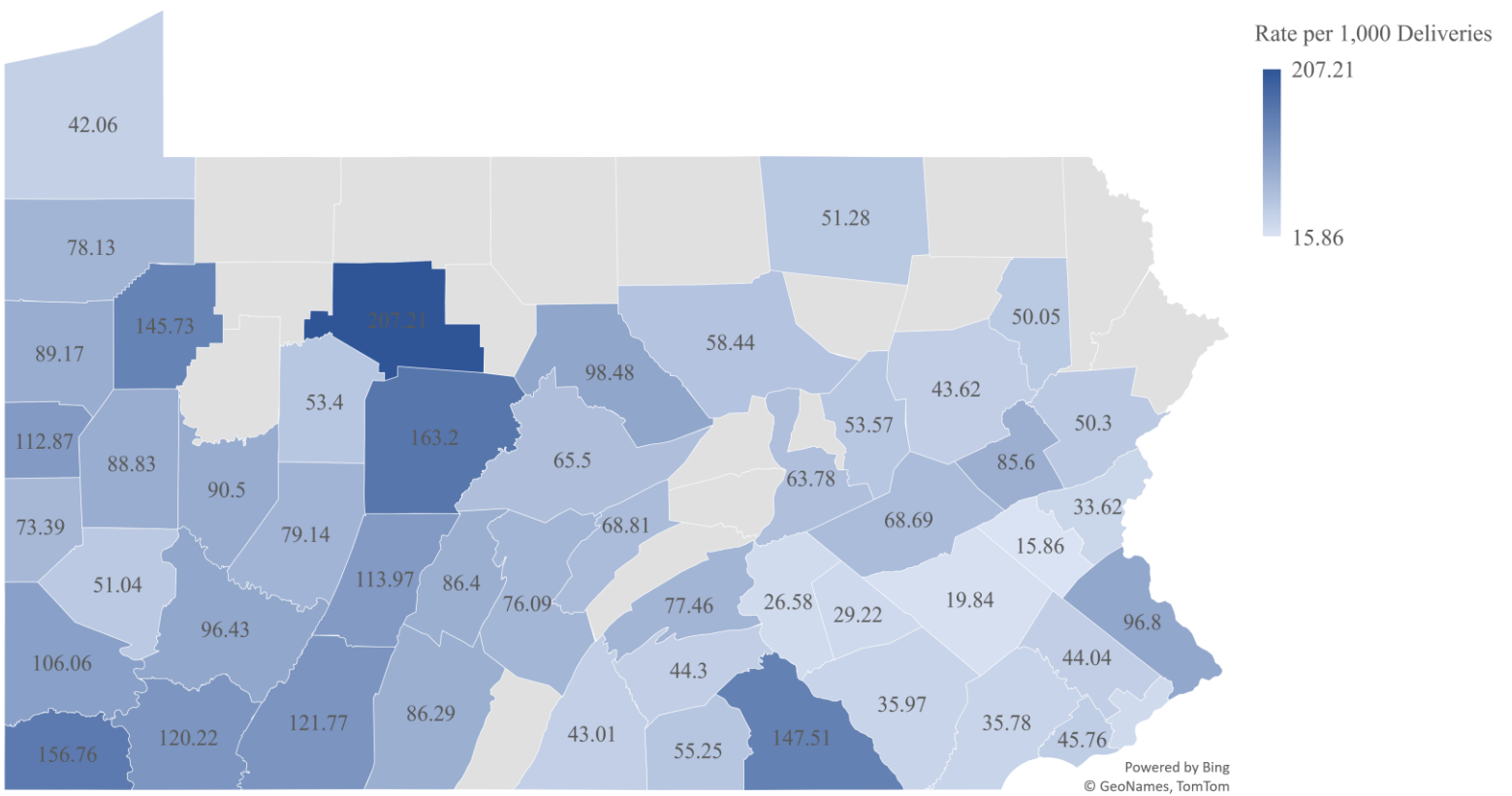

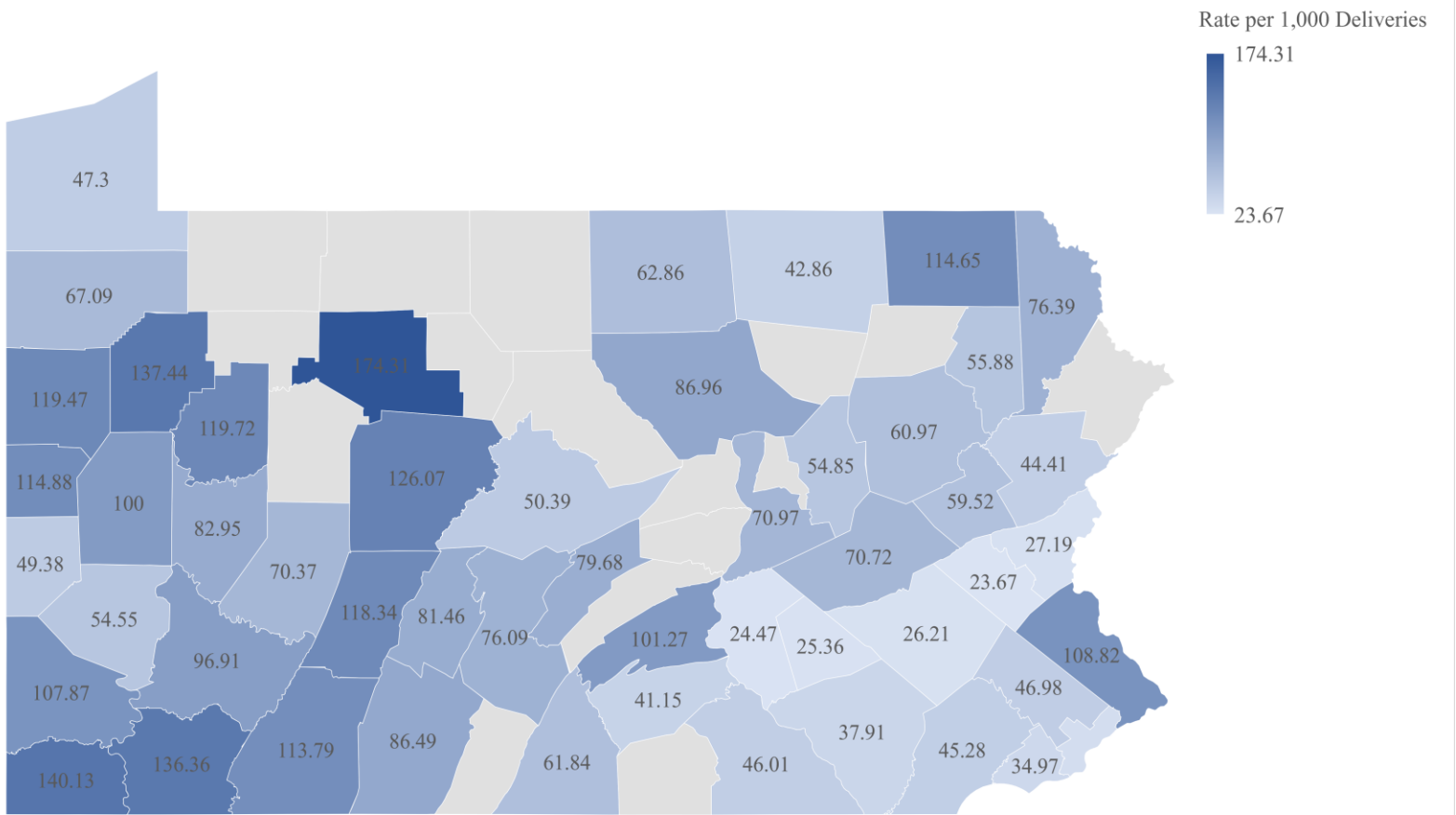
Rate of Women on Medical Assistance Diagnosed with OUD During Pregnancy, 2016



Rate of Women on Medical Assistance Diagnosed with OUD During Pregnancy, 2017

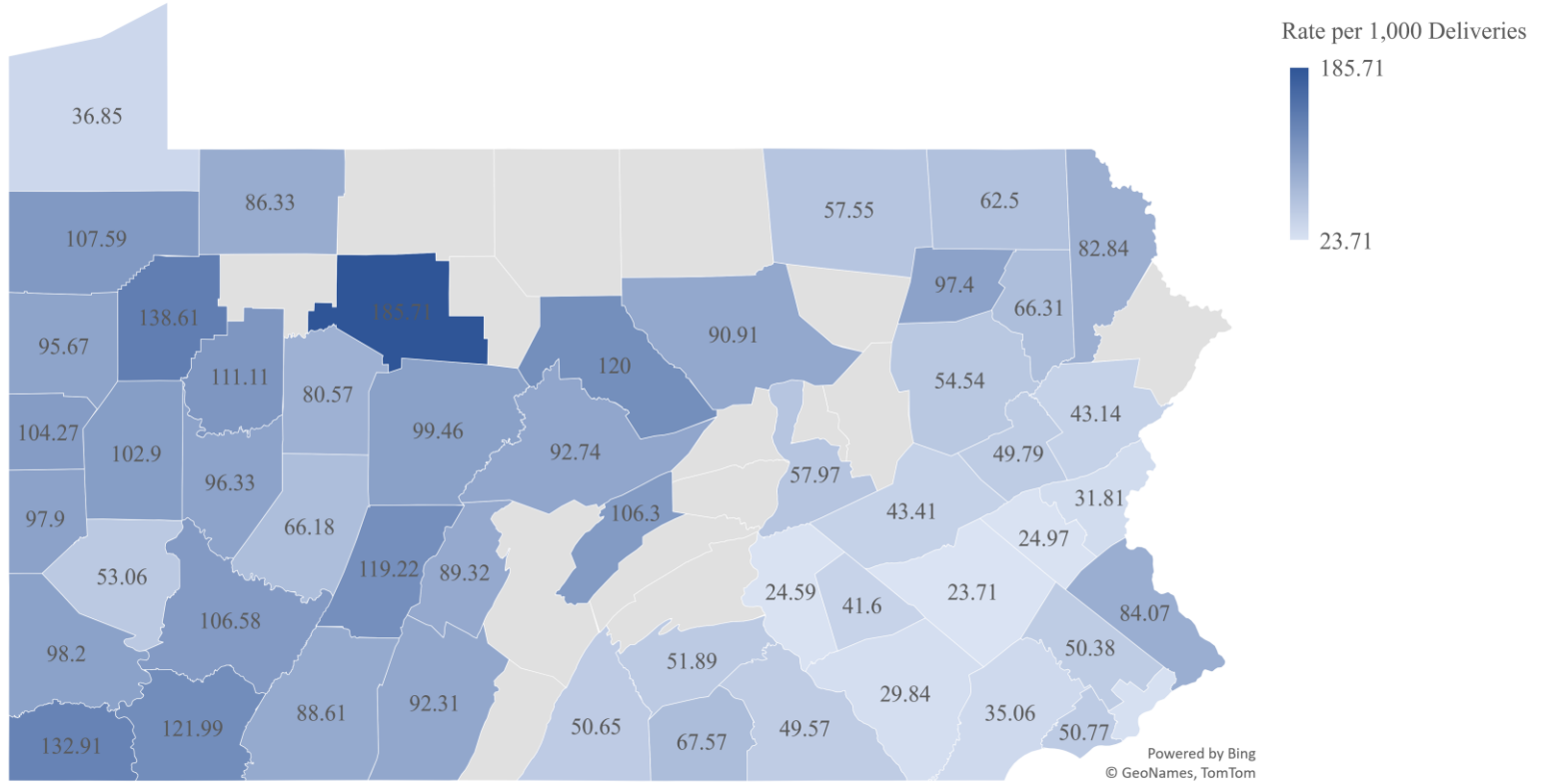


Rate of Women on Medical Assistance Diagnosed with OUD During Pregnancy, 2018



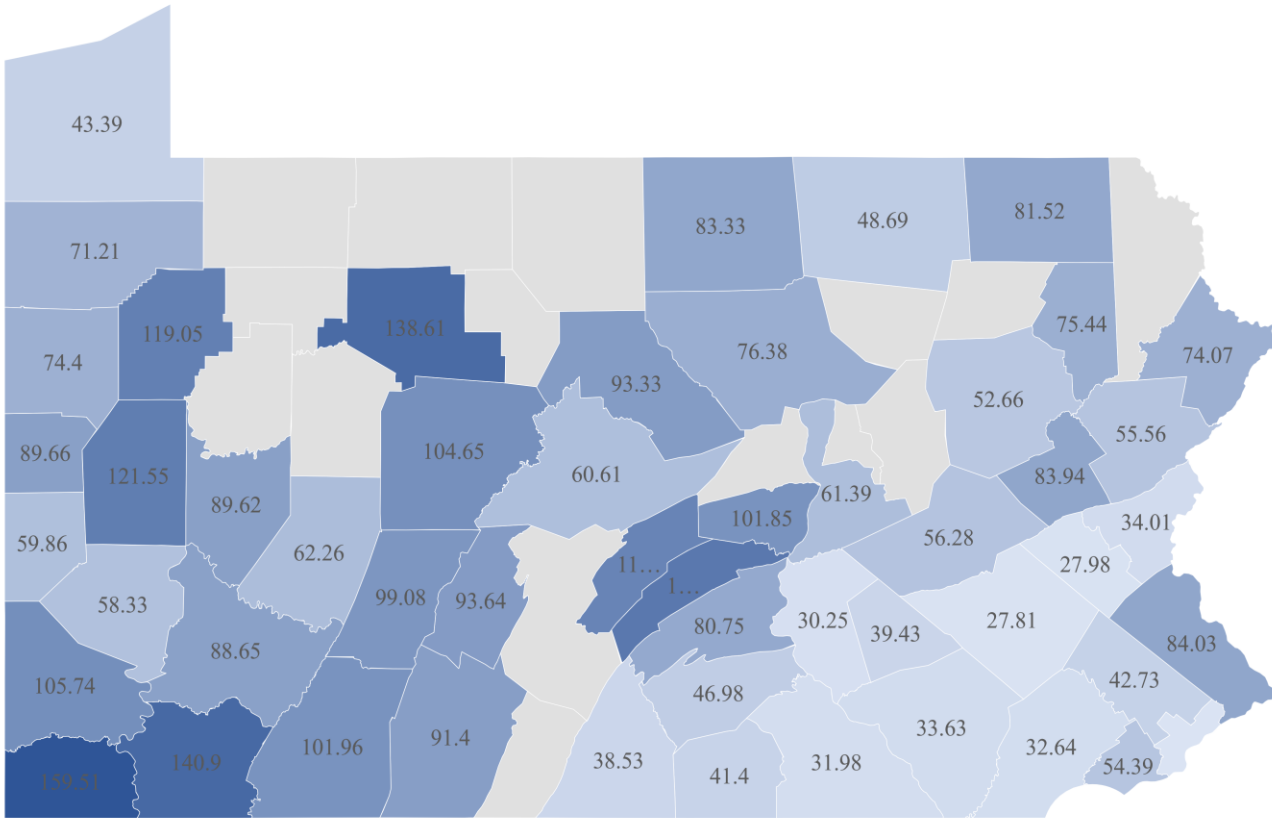
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Rate of Women on Medical Assistance Diagnosed with OUD During Pregnancy, 2019



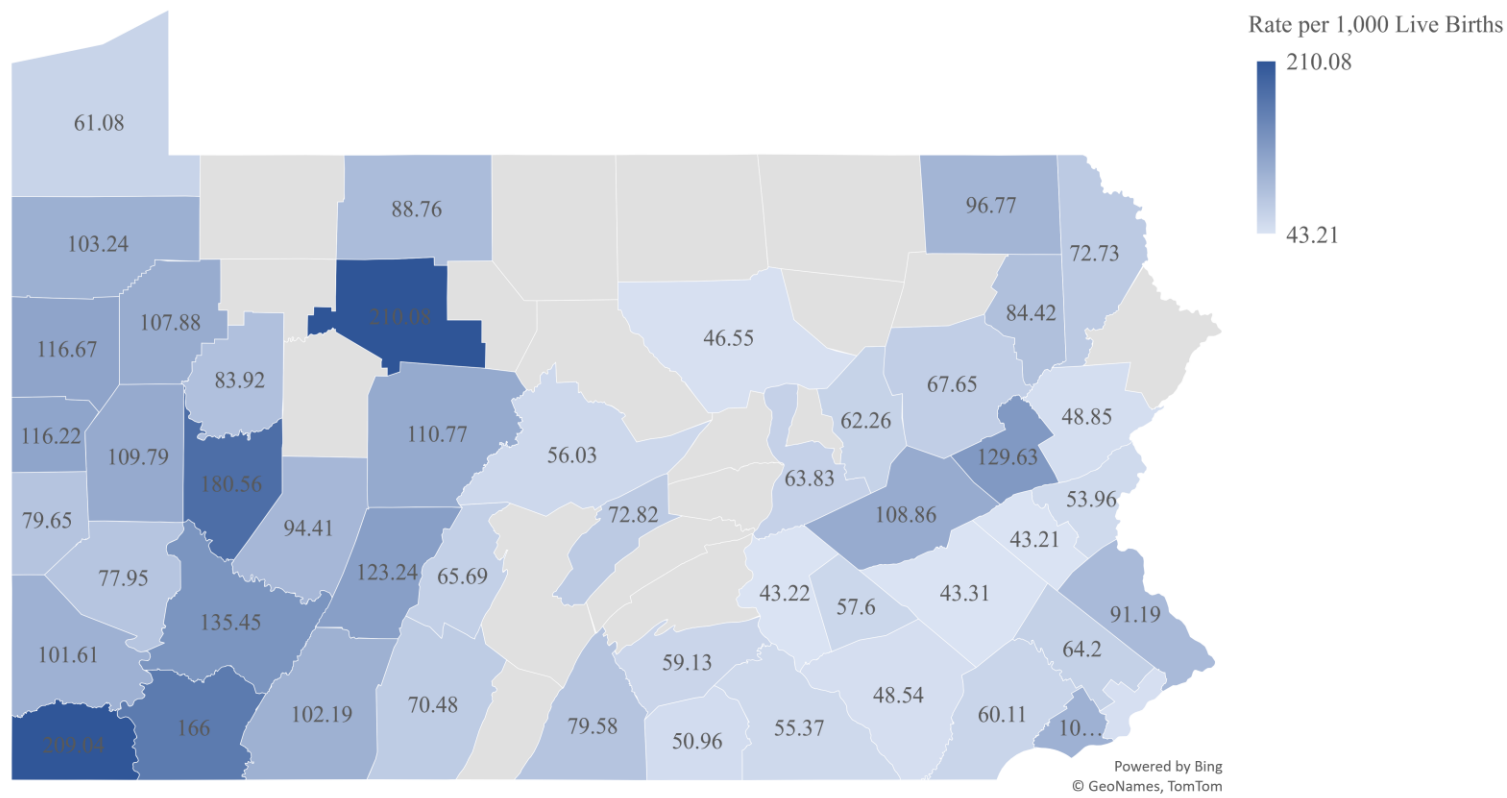
Rate of Women on Medical Assistance Diagnosed with OUD During Pregnancy, 2020

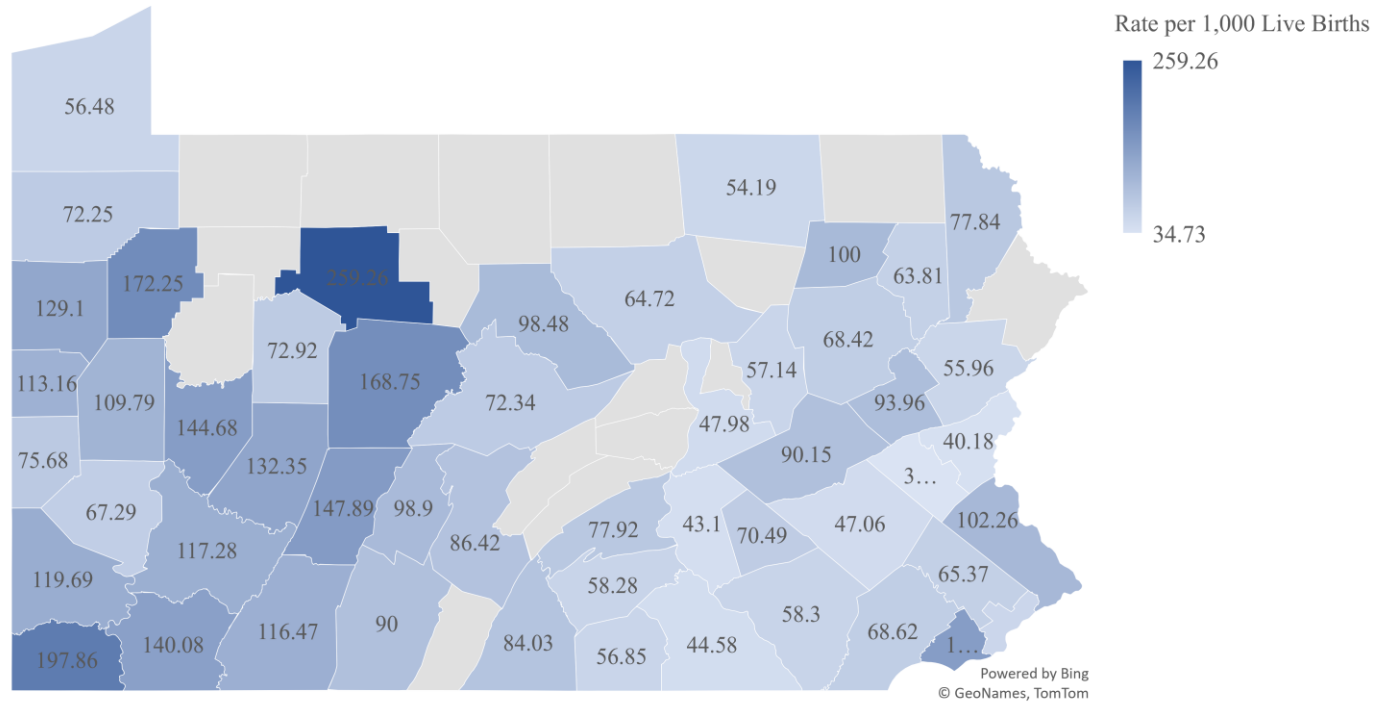


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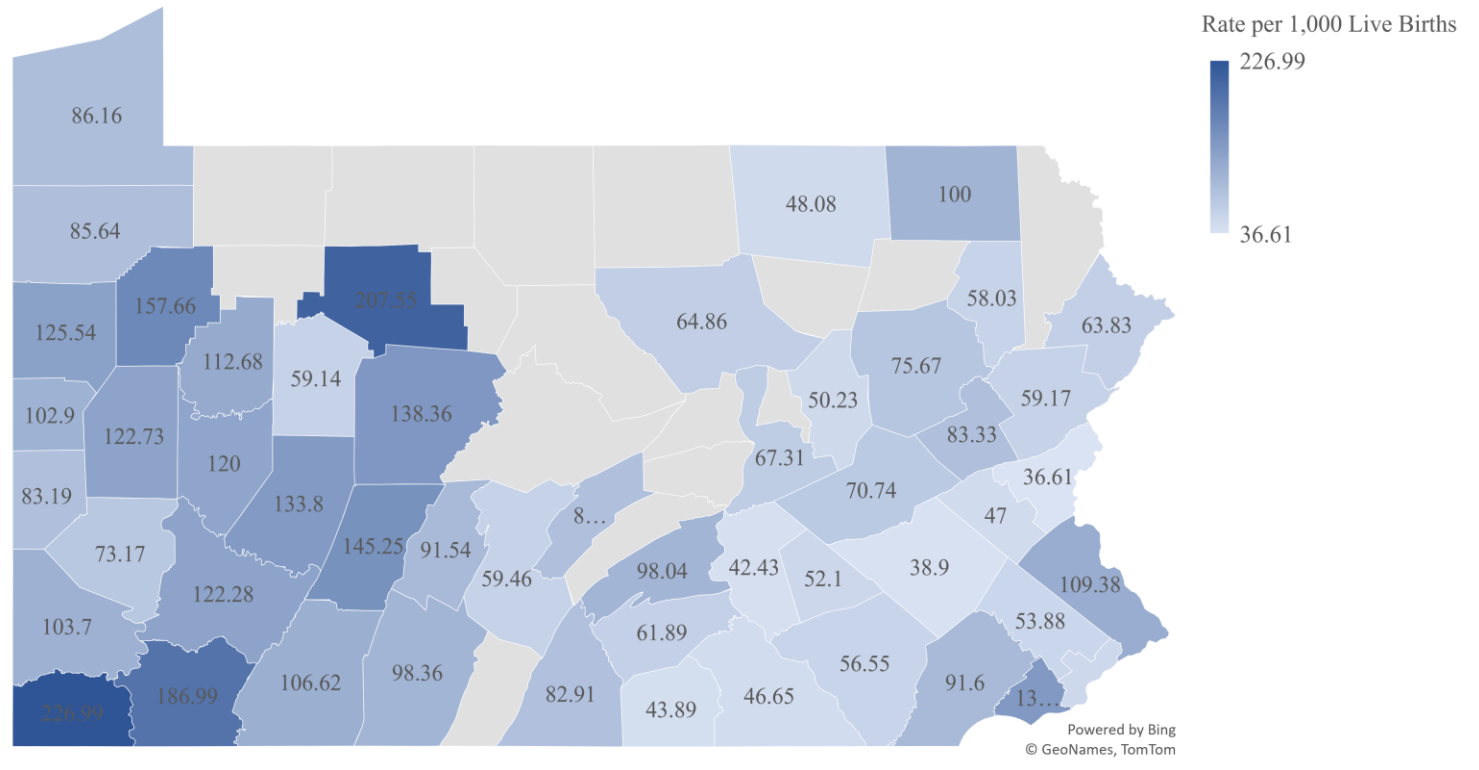
Rates of Newborns on Medical Assistance with NAS, 2016



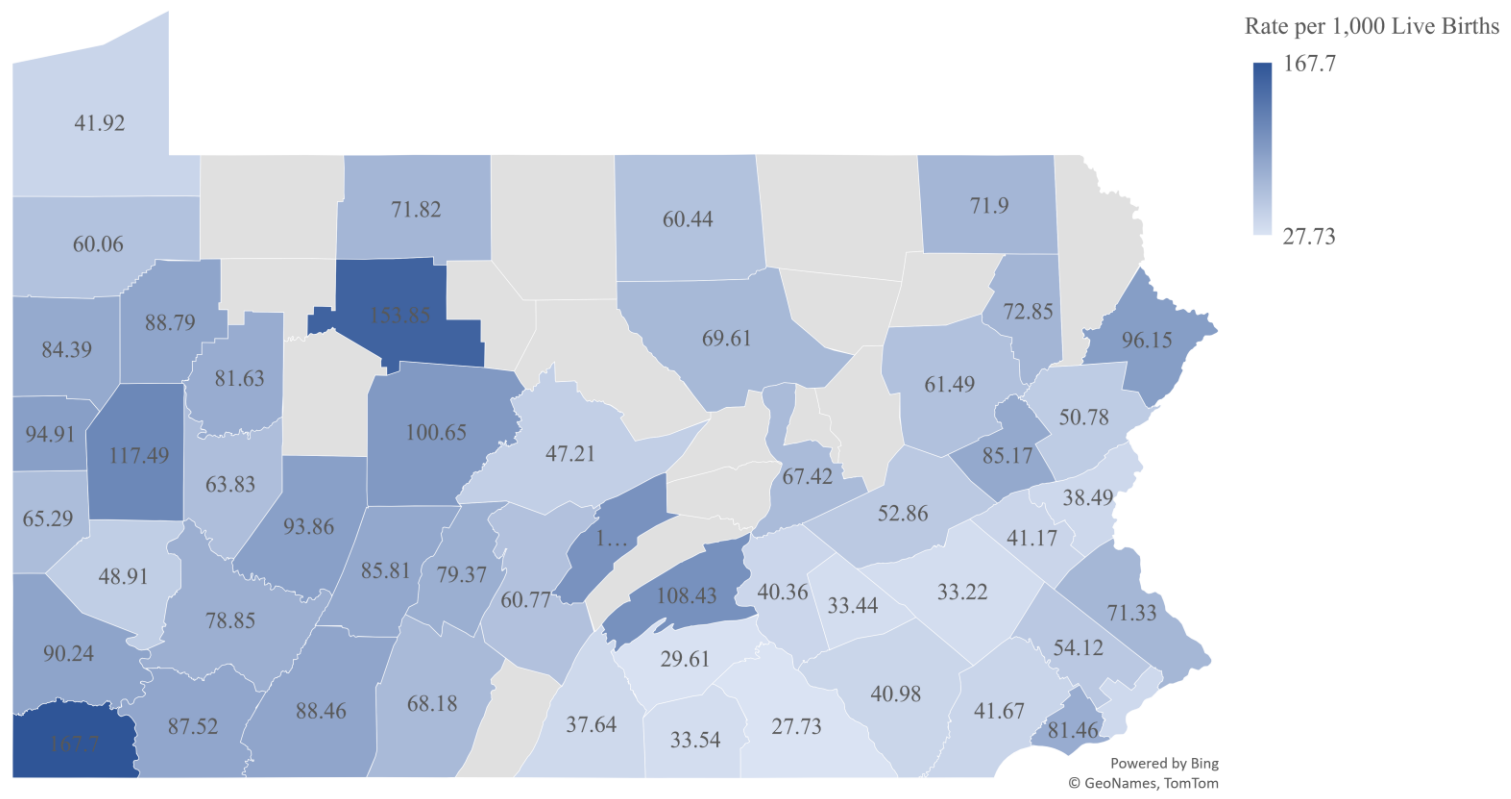
Rates of Newborns on Medical Assistance with NAS, 2017



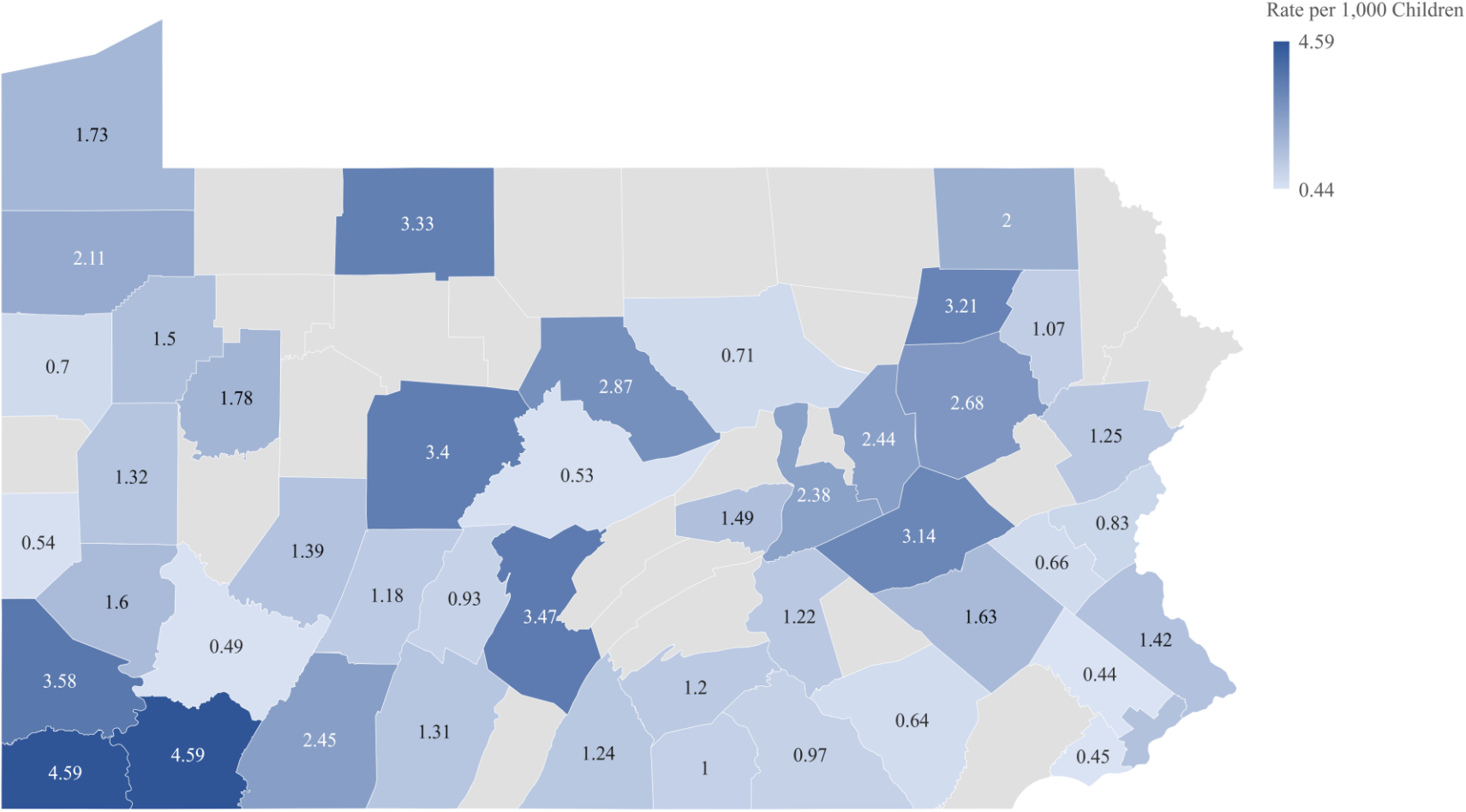
Rates of Newborns on Medical Assistance with NAS, 2018



Rates of Newborns on Medical Assistance with NAS, 2020

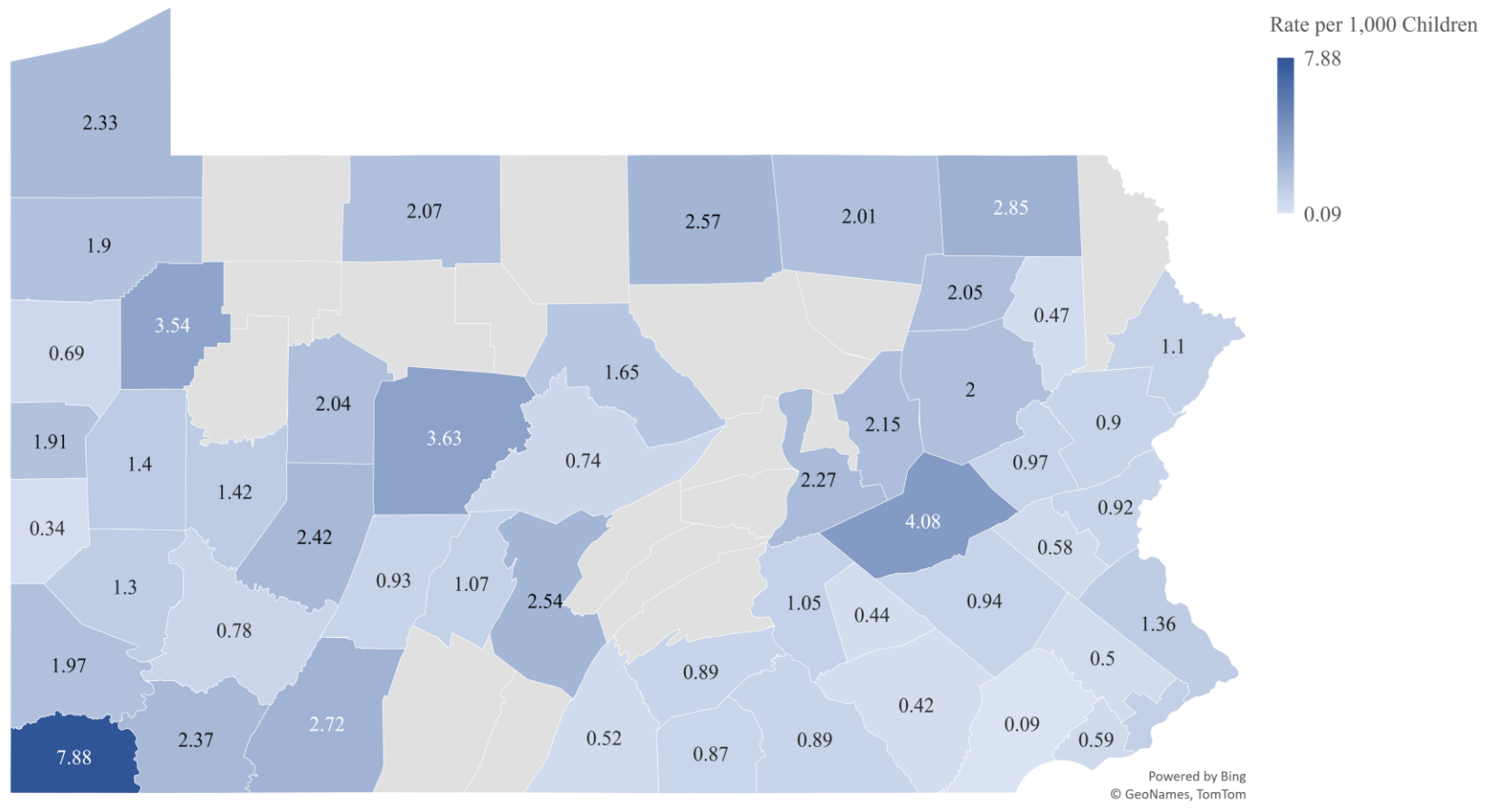


Dependent Children Removed from their Home Where Parental Drug Use was a Factor, 2017
